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
Bi-Weekly Hog Report

July 4, 2022

The Weekly Hog Report will take a summer break for July! The regular Bi-Weekly Hog Report will resume in mid-August.

Cash Slaughter Weight Hog Prices

United States <u>daily average</u> slaughter weight cash hog prices (National Negotiated) were higher early in the week before declining Thursday and Friday, to end the week lower. Cash hog prices on Friday July 1, averaged US\$114.22 per cwt, a price decline of US\$5.22 per cwt or 4.4 per cent from US\$119.44 per cwt the previous Friday. The negotiated weekly average National base price averaged US\$119.48 per cwt last week, a small decline of US\$0.87 per cwt from US\$120.35 per cwt the previous week.




Futures Markets

United States lean hog futures daily prices were mixed but overall lower to end the week lower, week-over-week. The nearby July 2022 contract settled Friday at US\$109.600 per cwt, a price decline of US\$1.325 per cwt from the previous Friday's close of US\$110.925 per cwt. The August 2022 contract declined US\$3.800 per cwt last week to settle Friday at US\$102.975 per cwt.

Cash Feeder Hog Prices

North American (Iowa) iso-wean (10-12lb) cash hog prices and feeder (40lb) prices were mixed last week. Weighted average <u>cash prices</u> for U.S. based iso-weans (12lb) were US\$38.02 per head last week, a price decline of US\$1.30 per head from US\$39.32 per head the previous week. Feeder (40lb) cash prices averaged US\$68.74 per head last week, a price increase of US\$1.87 per head from US\$66.87 per head the previous week.

Canadian Hog Markets

In Canada, the Signature#4 (Maple Leaf) Index 100 daily price for Thursday June 30, 2022, was \$246.51 per ckg, a price decline of \$1.51 per ckg from \$248.02 per ckg from the previous Friday.

United States Hogs Slaughtered

U.S. hogs slaughtered under federal inspection for the U.S. week ending July 2, 2022, were estimated at 2.286 million head, down 0.8 per cent from previous weeks estimates of 2.304 million head, but up 0.6 per cent from 2.272 million head the same week a year ago. Weekly U.S. hog slaughter numbers over the last four weeks averaged 2.329 million head, down 1.9 per cent from 2.375 million head over the same period in 2021. U.S hog slaughter numbers over the last eight weeks averaged 2.309 million head, down 0.9 per cent from 2.330 million head over the same period a year ago.

Meat Production

U.S. pork production for the week ending July 2, 2022, were estimated at 494.6 million lb., down 1.0 per cent from 499.4 million lb. the previous week, but up 4.1 per cent from 475.1 million lb. the same week a year ago. Pork production over the last four weeks ending July 2, 2022, were estimated to average 503.6 million lb., up 0.5 per cent from 501.0 million lb. over the same period a year ago. Pork production over the last eight weeks ending July 2, 2022, averaged 500.4 million lb., up 0.9 per cent from 495.7 million lb. the same period a year ago.

U.S. beef production for the week ending July 2, 2022, were estimated at 514.5 million lb., down 4.6 per cent from 539.1 million lb. the previous week, but up 0.5 per cent from 512.0 million lb. the same week a year ago.

Combined production of U.S. beef, pork, chicken, and turkey over the four weeks ending June 25, 2022, were estimated to average 2.160 billion lb., up 1.6 per cent from 2.1255 billion lb. over the same four weeks a year ago. Based on the weekly production numbers, U.S. meat production year-to-date for the first twenty-five weeks of 2022 was slightly lower (-0.045 per cent) compared to the same period a year ago.

While pork is still leading the annual production declines with a 3.2 per cent decline in pork production year-to-date for the first twenty-five weeks of 2022, turkey production over the last four weeks has declined 7.5 per cent, compared to the same period a year ago. Pork production over the last four weeks has managed to increase 0.4 percent, compared to same period a year ago.

Cutout Values

Pork cutout values for the week ending July 2, 2022, averaged US\$107.81 per cwt, a price decline of US\$3.36 per cwt or 3.0 per cent from US\$111.17 per cwt the previous week; and down 6.1 per cent from US\$114.80 per cwt from the same week a year ago. Belly prices declined 10.8 per cent from the previous week to average US\$144.48 per cwt, while loin prices declined 1.6 per cent to average US\$98.71 per cwt.

Choice beef cutout prices (600-900 lb.) for the week ending July 2, 2022, averaged US\$265.70 per cwt over the week, a slight price decline of US\$0.35 per cwt from US\$266.05 per cwt from the previous week; and down 8.6 per cent from US\$290.83 per cwt the same week a year ago.

Average chicken cutout values (breast) for the week ending July 2, averaged US\$302.45 per cwt, a price decline of US\$12.04 per cwt or 3.8 per cent from US\$314.49 per cwt from the previous week, but up 63.8 per cent from US\$184.65 per cwt from the same week a year ago.

USDA Hogs and Pigs Report

USDA released the June *Hogs and Pigs Report* on June 29, 2022. Total U.S. hog inventory numbers as of June 1, 2022, was estimated at 72.524 million head, down 0.86 per cent from 73.153 million head on June 1, 2021, and down slightly from March 1, 2022. The total annual inventory decline from June 2021 was 0.86 per cent which was more than the 0.3 per cent average decline estimated by the trade analysts.

Breeding herd inventory numbers in the United States as of June 1, 2022, was estimated at 6.168 million head, down 0.84 per cent from 6.220 million head on June 1, 2021, but up 1.15 per cent from 6.098 million head on March 1, 2022. Breeding herd numbers declined 0.84 per cent while the average trade analyst estimates were expecting a smaller decline of about 0.5 per cent.

Market herd inventory numbers in the United States as of June 1, 2022, were estimated at 66.356 million head, down 0.86 per cent from 66.933 million head on June 1, 2021, and

0.25 per cent lower from 66.521 million head on March 1, 2022. Trade analysts were estimating market inventory numbers to decline by only 0.3 per cent (year/year); which was a smaller decline than the actual reported decline of 0.86 per cent by USDA.

Sow farrowing numbers for the March-to-May 2022 period totaled 2.992 million head, a 1.4 per cent decline from 3.034 million head farrowed the same quarter a year ago, which was higher than the <u>0.7 percent decline</u> estimated by trade analysts.

USDA reported farrowing intentions for the June-to-August 2022 period were estimated at 3.019 million head, a decrease of 1.0 per cent from the same quarter a year ago. Trade analysts were projecting only a farrowing decline of 0.3 per cent. USDA farrowing intentions for the September-to-November 2022 period were estimated to decline 1.4 per cent, a larger decline then the slight 0.1 per cent decline estimated by trade analysts.

USDA reported March-to-May 2022 pig crop was 32.905 million head, a decline of 1.0 per cent from the same quarter in 2021. Trade analysts had estimated a smaller decline of 0.7 per cent in the pig crop for the period.

The *USDA Hogs and Pigs Report* numbers were overall more positive compared to the pre-estimates. Both market inventory numbers and breeding herd numbers were slightly lower than expected which should be viewed as a slight positive. Also, the smaller pig crop and lower farrowing intentions over the next two quarters should be viewed as a slight positive.

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
